SNSF Support specifically for Women Scientists

PRIMA : since 2017 - five-year fellowships – stepping stone to professorship

PRIMA grants are aimed at excellent female researchers from Switzerland and abroad who aspire to a professorship in Switzerland. PRIMA grantees lead their own research project at a Swiss higher education institution. They work independently and have a team of their own.

12 awards per year across all disciplines. Next submission November 2018.

SNSF Gender Equality Grant: 1000CHF per year for career support measures, if you have postdoc mobility award, Ambizione award or SNSF project funding (not NCCRs)

Marie-Heim-Vögtlin Award (discontinued)

Awards designed to support women returning from a career break in relation to having a family

SNSF funding and support for Scientists

- **Flexibility Grant** (formerly 120% grant) **for** postdocs and PhD students with families: aimed at young researchers with children during an important stage in their career and who therefore need more flexibility

- **SNSF Mobility Grants for Doctoral Students:** awarded for 6 to 12 months and supports stays abroad, including conferences and workshops up to 20,000CHF
